Approximate expenditure would be at £3'000.

Approximate expenditure would be at £1'500.

Tree Carving in Stanhope Park.

Approximate expenditure would be at £3'000. – this work is to be carried out on a tree which is on poor health, therefore would not affect a healthy tree.

Council has £5'000 in the funds for such project. It was discussed that the TC would seek further funding of up to £10'000 to cater for an event for the VE Celebrations.

Charlie Yelland to be approached about the Pipes.

VE DAY CELEBRATIONS W/END 8TH – 10TH MAY 2020 – PROPOSAL CLLR.HUTCHINGS

In the Manor Car Park, TDC will hopefully not charge but could use our free days parking if not.

Use Fair Stage.

Use Memorial Hall for toilets, storage etc.

Use Council Market tables and hire any extra.

Fair has 300 chairs, hire any extra needed.

Put the tables and chairs in lines looking at the stage.

Sell tickets at £1 or £2 so we know how many chairs we need.

People bring their own picnic but a few food vendors on site.

Memorial Hall Bar open .

We will need security – I suggest fencing off so we can control the area safely.
