The Chairman asked Councillors to declare any interests on items on the Agenda as they arose.

#### 358. Presentation from Walter Wonnacott, Planning Consultant from WMW Consultant Ltd.

Mr. Wonnacott attended the Planning & Highways meeting to outline the proposal for 1/0226/2019/FUL. The current application is different to the 2 previous applications which had been refused. This application therefore was for a one level property with did not overlook neighbouring properties and gave more space on the site.

It was explained that his property would be a contemporary/unusual build, all on flat surface, it would be about a 1/3 bigger than a normal site build.

After discussion it was clarified that this build has one (1) parking space with an additional temporary space for visitors.

Cllr. Hutchings asked whether the Solar Panels on the building would be at an angle to cause glare problems to neighbouring properties. Mr. Wonnacott stated that these could be adjusted accordingly, as well as being placed on a roofing frame, he made a note of this concern.
